As you will all be aware, every child's attendance is tracked very carefully and we do this because our job is to make sure that your child receives the education that they deserve. We know and can see that if a child misses more than 4% of school a year, they will not reach the educational standard expected of them and their attitude to school is at risk of becoming negative and challenging.

We have noticed that having focussed on attendance on a Friday has made a direct impact on having a greater number of children at school, Monday is now a day where absence is increasing.

We can see that children quite often come to school on a Monday very tired, which means that that the children are having far too many late nights and are not ready for a very full day at school. We are committed to planning excellent experiences for your child so we need you to work in partnership to bring them to school. We will be contacting families whose child's attendance is of concern to us to offer support and share our expectation. Thank you.
