

Dear Families,

Monday 6th July 2020

I do hope that you are well and that you were pleased with your child's end of academic year report.

As previously suggested, our transition plans have had to be adapted to ensure that all children have the opportunity to meet their new classteacher and teaching assistant and then have an opportunity to say 'thank you and farewell' too. These next few weeks will be very busy for staff, as they begin to ensure that discussions about their current classes carefully inform the next teacher. It is really important to us, that when the children do return in September, that every member of staff has a good understanding of the needs and wants of the children in front of them.

This letter will inform you of your child's new classteacher and teaching assistant and how to meet your child's classteacher and teaching assistant `virtually'.

We will be welcoming two members of staff to the teaching team this academic year and this will be Mrs Noble who will be the new Presley classteacher and Mrs Dickson who will be the Luther King classteacher.

Mrs Noble already works within our BeDifferent Federation and she is coming from Lonesome Primary School and Mrs Dickson, as many of you know already has taught many of our children whilst at William Morris Primary School. I am very lucky to be in a position of deploying staff from across the Federation to ensure that they continue to develop professionally, whilst being able to remain with us.

Our Year 5 teaching team and myself have decided to review the combination of children that are currently in Year 5 and we have re-grouped both classes, based on friendships, ability and ensuring that we have a balanced split of boys and girls. You will be text separately today to inform you of your child's class for September 2020. The text that you will receive will indicate as to whether your child is in Gates or Glennie Class.

Please find the Staffing Structure for 2020-2021 confirming the classes and staffing for the next academic year. I have also included a table of the entire staffing team and their roles in our school, for your reference.

As I am sure that you will have been expecting, the usual handover session planned for staff and their new classes will be somewhat different this year. This year the staff teaching your child/ren have prepared a 'welcome' video for you to access from the google classroom. This video will be accessible to you using the username and password previously accessed by you when viewing the staff

The guidance from the Government is still being sent to us as Headteachers and I am sure that more will come in the next few weeks and months. As I have always said to you, I am only ever keen to communicate a finite plan, during these times of uncertainty and speculation so that my staff, you and the children understand what the expectations are of you and why they are this way.

I have continually appreciated your patience and support during these times and I would like to thank you again.
