#### Instructions

Read a range of example instructional texts and identify the features  
Write a set of instructions for a novice Viking about how to catch a dragon  
Develop the use of multi-clause sentences using coordinating and subordinating conjunctions

#### Descriptive writing

Write a description of different dragons to compile a 'Dragon-spotter's guide'  
Use expanded noun phrases and adverbial phrases of manner and place  
Read writing aloud to an audience

#### Recounts

Write a recount of the highlights of Year 4 to share in our reports

### Languages

Play games involving describing the weather in French.  
Play games to learn the numbers to 40 in French.  
Create and present a weather report in French.

Develop strategies for acting on an unfair situation

#### Athletics:

Develop jumping techniques - high jump, long jump

#### HISTORY:

Learn about Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots

- resistance by Alfred the Great and Athelstan, first king of England  
-further Viking invasions and Danegeld - Anglo-Saxon laws and justice

#### SCIENCE: Electricity

Identify common appliances that run on electricity  
Construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers  
Identify and test whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery.  
Use a comparative test to identify the best material to make a switch.

#### COMPUTING: Digital literacy

Use typing software to improve typing speed and accuracy  
Learn how to use the spell-check feature when word processing  
Use word processing software to publish personal pieces of writing – create an advert for a new Viking tribe member and a Dragon Spotter's Guide

### Expressive Art and Design

#### Design and Technology:

Use research and develop design criteria to inform the design of innovative, functional, appealing products that are fit for purpose, aimed at particular individuals or groups  
Select from and use a wider range of materials and components, including construction materials, textiles and ingredients, according to their functional properties and aesthetic qualities
