Pupil premium children have performed better than non-pupil premium children working at secure+ in reading and Mathematics and the variance in the case of writing is 2%. There is a greater percentage of pupil premium children exceeding the age-related expectation in Mathematics compared with non-pupil premium children and the percentage of pupil premium children working at greater depth in reading and writing is small compared with non-pupil premium children (1% and 6% variance respectively).

Pupil premium children have made better progress than non-pupil premium children in reading and Mathematics. Non-pupil premium children have made slightly better progress (5% variance) than pupil premium children in writing.

Pupil premium children have made the same progress as non-pupil premium children in reading and writing and greater progress in Mathematics.
