Pupil premium in Year 2 have not performed as well as non-pupil premium children in reading, writing and Mathematics. However, the variance in the percentage of children working at greater depth in reading and writing is less than 10% (7% and 5% respectively).

Pupil premium children have made better progress than non-pupil premium children in reading, with 88% of pupil premium children making expected progress in this area. However, 8% less pupil premium children have made



expected progress in writing and 15% less pupil premium children have made expected progress in Mathematics compared to non-pupil premium children.

Pupil premium in Year 6 have not performed as well as non-pupil premium children in reading, writing and Mathematics. Of the 12 Pupil Premium children, 6 are also on the SEN register.

Pupil premium children have made less progress than non-pupil premium children in reading, writing and Mathematics. However, progress of Pupil Premium children in writing is only 9% lower than that of non-Pupil Premium children.
