

BeDifferent Bookworm

Reading at home is an essential activity that families can do to support their child's reading, writing, imagination and creativity while also fostering a life-long love of reading for pleasure. Children who are heard read regularly at home, or who enjoy listening to stories each day, are more likely to pick up a book for enjoyment and not just because we tell them to.

One of our many reading initiatives introduced this term was the BeDifferent Bookworm. In each of our Year 1 – 3 classrooms, teachers have set up a Bookworm display to celebrate reading at home. Each child has their own tracker which is ticked off daily by their classteacher to indicate when they have been read with at home. Any child who is heard read at least four times in a week receives a special BeDifferent Bookworm sticker. If they receive a sticker every week for the half term, they then receive a very special bookmark to celebrate their efforts in reading.
