This prestigious award recognises schools that are dedicated to improving and supporting the mental health and wellbeing of children, staff and families and to ensuring that the pupil voice is very much at the heart of everything they do.

Our feedback during this process included:

'Children I spoke with were very knowledgeable about strategies they can use to support their own and other's Emotional Wellbeing and Mental Health. They know where and how to get help when they need it and can describe what they have discussed in PSHE, on wellbeing days and in assemblies.'

'The school buildings are attractive and welcoming. Displays are impressive and considerable effort has been put into making classrooms bright and cheerful spaces. All have zones of regulation displays and regulation stations/calm corners with a range of toys.'

'Pupil voice is effective. One example given was how children's views have influenced the programme of Friday afternoon activities. They have also been involved in, for example, discussions about the developing role of the school's Playground Peacemakers.'

'Staff receive regular training around PSHE and EWMH, as well as additional bespoke support provided by an EP and the school's inclusion lead.'
