The timetabling of our school day will remain very similar this half-term, with greater opportunities for PE, Geography, cross-curricular reading and Personal, Social and Emotional development learning opportunities. We will continue to stream our Mathematics teaching but will reduce the daily amount of mathematical learning from 1 hour and 30 minutes, back to an hour. The additional Rapid Recovery time for identified children will allow for that additional time spent rehearsing much needed mathematical skills. We are very mindful of curriculum overload so we have structured our week accordingly.

Your child will still need to wear their PE kit on their allocated PE day but please make sure that your child has a water bottle daily and that on very warm, sunny days your child has a hat/cap and are smothered in a high factor sun cream. This is something that you **must** apply ahead of the school day starting.
